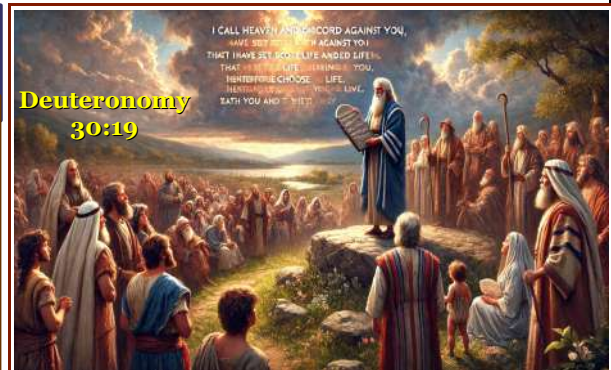

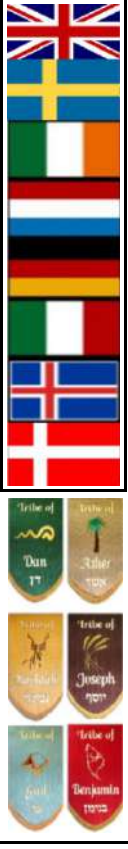

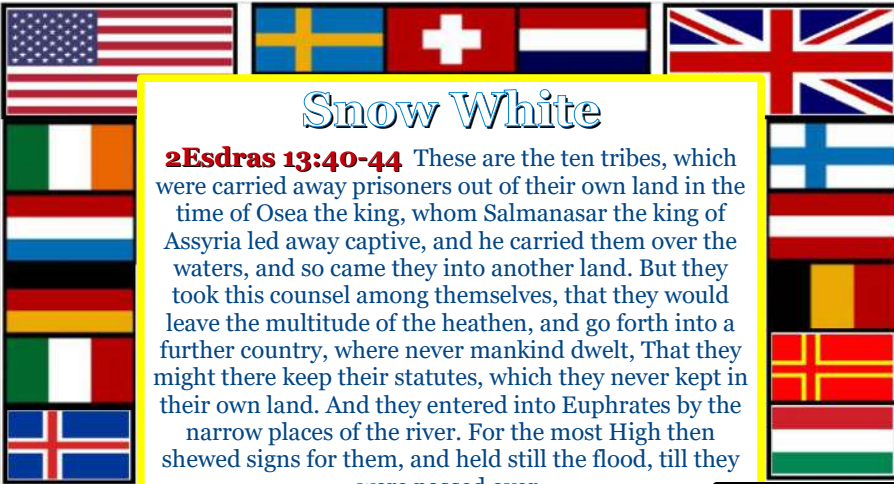

Snow White

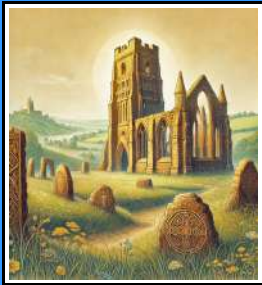

Snow White: A Tale of Wandering Israel

This timeless fairy tale, when viewed through the lens of ancient Israel's history, mirrors the migrations of Israel (Snow White) from Assyria through northern Europe to England reflected in the prophecies of Isaiah, Jeremiah, Daniel, and John, intertwined with the imagery of Revelation.

The Wicked Queen symbolizes Rome and the Roman papacy, often described as Sodom, Egypt, and Babylon. Snow White's wandering through the forest recalls Revelation 6, where God prepares a place for His people—primarily England, represented in the story as the dwarfs' cottage. The seven dwarfs symbolize the seven church ages, with the first Christian church in England established by Joseph of Arimathea around 38 AD at Glastonbury. These churches, alongside Israel's industrious activities in their new homeland, fulfilled God's plan. The blending of the church (the candlestick) and Israel (the olive tree) reflects the two witnesses in Revelation: the House of Judah and the House of Israel, united in testimony. The dwarfs' mourning over Snow White's enchanted sleep parallels the church's sorrow during spiritual decline. The Queen's deceptive gifts symbolize the allure of idolatry, and Snow White's slumber mirrors the spiritual apathy caused by this corruption.

The Prince's love for Snow White and her revival from the poisoned apple signifies Christ's redeeming love for His people, awakening them to eternal life. Their union reflects the ultimate fulfillment of God's promises.

This allegory underscores the identity that Israel's descendants are found among the Anglo-Saxon, Celtic, Scandinavian, Germanic and European kindred peoples, wherever they may dwell, whose folklore bears witness to their enduring role in God's plan.

Sleeping Beauty A Symbolic Tale of Israel's Journey

The story of Sleeping Beauty parallels Israel's journey after the Assyrian captivity, their migration across Europe, and their eventual settlement in places like Germany, England, and America. The king and queen's longing for a child reflects Abraham and Sarah's plight, with the frog symbolizing God's voice and promise. The 12 golden plates represent the 12 tribes of Israel, linked to the constellations and their divine attributes. The uninvited 13th fairy embodies the power of Christ or Satan, signifying the struggle between divine purpose and human folly.

The princess pricking her finger and falling into a deep sleep mirrors Israel's spiritual slumber and loss of identity, dulled by modernism and lukewarm faith, as described in Revelation 3. The 100-year sleep symbolizes a set period for Israel's oblivion, during which their true heritage is hidden, like the castle shrouded in thorns.

Attempts by other princes to rescue the sleeping princess represent martyrs and faithful believers who fought against persecution and false beliefs. Yet only the destined Prince, at the appointed time, could awaken her with a kiss, symbolizing Christ's redemption and the awakening of Israel to their true identity as God's chosen people.

This awakening heralds the fulfillment of Isaiah's prophecy (Isaiah 60:1) and the joyous union of Christ and His people, culminating in the marriage of the Lamb (Revelation 19:7). The kingdom revives, and all creation rejoices, reflecting the ultimate restoration and perfection promised in God's plan.

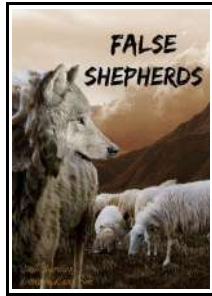

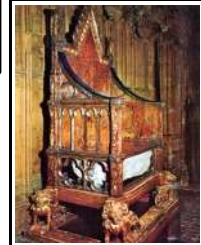

Cinderella

A Symbolic Tale of Israel's Servanthood and Redemption

The story of Cinderella reflects Israel's role as God's servant people, enduring hardship and humiliation yet ultimately chosen for divine purpose.

Cinderella, like Israel, is depicted as a servant clothed in rags, smeared with ashes, and enduring the mockery of her two stepsisters. These sisters symbolize oppressive forces tied to the Babylonian system—one ecclesiastical, the other economic—under the influence of "Mystery Babylon" (Revelation 17:5).

Cinderella's humble request for a tree branch instead of jewels and finery signifies Israel's spiritual focus over materialism, aligning with the biblical symbolism of the "branch" as royalty and divine promise (Ezekiel 17). Her tears nurturing the branch reflect Israel's sorrow and repentance during her period of punishment, enduring 2520 years of exile and tribulation.

The white dove represents the Holy Spirit, offering comfort and guidance to Israel in her times of suffering. The golden and silver garments provided by the dove symbolize the righteousness of saints and readiness for the marriage of the Lamb (Revelation 19:7).

Cinderella's transformation and recognition by the prince mirror Israel's ultimate redemption and restoration as God's chosen bride, prepared to enter the Kingdom of Heaven.

The prince's unwavering focus on Cinderella reflects Christ's exclusive devotion to His people.

The story concludes with their joyous union, foretold in Revelation as the marriage of the Lamb, symbolizing the fulfillment of God's covenant and the restoration of His kingdom on Earth.

Hansel & Gretel: A Symbolic Tale of Israel's Division, Captivity, and Redemption

The father, identified as Jacob, symbolizes Israel's patriarch and the covenant established with God, as seen in the stone of Bethel. The Stone of Destiny.

The breadcrumbs Hansel scatters symbolize the Word of God, left as signs for Israel's descendants during their wanderings. Yet, these breadcrumbs are consumed by birds, representing God's judgment and the prohibition of an immediate return to their homeland. The children's discovery of the gingerbread house—built of bread but covered in cakes—symbolizes the early Christian faith of the British Isles, mingled with the pagan rituals that followed Israel on their journey.

The witch represents the Church of Rome, initially appearing hospitable but ultimately seeking to control and harm Israel. Her demise at Gretel's hands reflects the eventual collapse of Babylonian systems, both religious and economic, as foretold in Revelation 18.

The children's crossing of the great body of water on the back of a white duck symbolizes the Holy Spirit's guidance, leading Israel to their true home. This home, representing the Kingdom of God, is a place of joy, unity, and restoration where God, their Father, welcomes them with open arms.

Hansel and Gretel's story is a parable of Israel's trials, punishment, and ultimate redemption. It underscores God's promise to regather His people, nourish them with His Word, and prepare them to build His kingdom on Earth.

The wolf's defeat and the release of Red Riding Hood and her grandmother mirror the first resurrection described in Revelation 20. The scissors symbolize Christ's Word, which will cut through deception, liberate the faithful, and bring the glory of the resurrection. This story encapsulates the promise of redemption and the fulfillment of God's covenant with Israel.

The bear represents the great world powers, particularly the economic and political systems typified by Babylon.

Initially appearing as a harmless visitor, the bear later symbolizes the insidious and dominating influence of the global systems, their orchestrated events, and their oppression through usury and debt.

The dwarf, encountered repeatedly by the sisters, embodies the ecclesiastical and material power and greed of the Roman Church, tied to the Babylonian system, highlighting the Vatican's exploitation of nations and resources.

The dwarf's desperate attempt to sacrifice Snow White and Rose Red reflects Magog effort to destroy Israel. The climax comes with the dwarf's demise, symbolizing Babylon's fall as prophesied in Revelation 17 and 18. This liberates the bear, who sheds his savage form to reveal himself as the King's Son, heralding Christ's righteous kingdom and the end of Babylon's oppression.

The prince's triumph ensures Israel's restoration under God, culminating in the union of the Lamb and His bride.

The tale begins with the brothers' banishment, paralleling Israel's scattering among nations. Their escape and establishment in a distant cottage symbolize the Tribes' migrations to the British Isles, fulfilling prophetic declarations of God appointing a new home for His people in the northwest. This new land became a sanctuary where the grace of the Gospel flourished. The return of the sister represents the reunification of the tribes, a revival of their identity and faith. The early Celtic Church in the British Isles, planted by Joseph of Arimathea, became a beacon of pure devotion, aligning with Jesus' commission to the apostles to guide Lost Israel's scattered flock.

The story concludes with a vision of restoration and the establishment of God's Kingdom on earth, a promise echoed by prophets like Ezra, Jeremiah and Isaiah. It reminds us of the enduring role of Anglo-Saxon Israel, embodied by Great Britain and the United States, as the birthright nations leading the fulfillment of God's covenant with Jacob's descendants.

The Enchanted Stag

The fate of the ten tribes of Israel after their Assyrian captivity remains a mystery, as prophecy intended for them to lose their identity but not their Heritage. Many identify these tribes with the Anglo-Saxon and Celtic peoples, who, after escaping Assyria, migrated through Europe to Saxony, Denmark, England, and Scotland. This narrative parallels the Saxon folktale of a brother and sister who endure hardships under a cruel stepmother, symbolizing Israel's trials and eventual transformation.

The siblings wander into the woods, where the brother is warned by his sister not to drink from streams that would turn him into a tiger or wolf, representing Assyria and Imperial Rome, respectively. However, at the third stream, the brother drinks and is transformed into a stag, symbolizing Israel's loss of identity and emergence as the Saxon people. The sister, akin to a guardian angel, represents Israel's guiding spirit, preserving the truth of their heritage.

The story continues with the stag's life in the forest and his sister's care, until a king discovers them. The king marries the sister, but their peace is disrupted by the wicked stepmother, who embodies the corrupt powers of the Roman Church. Ultimately, justice is served, the stepmother and her daughter are destroyed, and the brother regains his Adamic form, symbolizing Israel's eventual restoration.

The tale mirrors biblical prophecy, where Israel's identity remains hidden until the fall of the Beast of Revelation. The Enchanted Stag serves as a parable, urging spiritual perception to recognize Israel's journey and destiny. Only with the coming of The Christ will Israel's true identity and heritage be fully revealed.

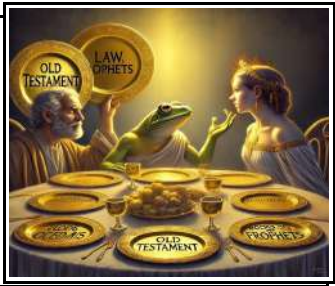

The Frog King

This Saxon Folktale can be seen as an allegory of Israel's history, spiritual journey, and destiny.

It reflects the covenant between God and Israel, their fall into disobedience, and eventual redemption through Jesus Christ.

The golden ball symbolizes the covenant gifted by God to Israel, His chosen people. When the youngest princess (Israel) loses the ball in a deep well, it parallels Israel's breaking of the covenant and descent into exile and captivity.

The crying of the princess mirrors Israel's lament in exile, punished for forsaking God's commandments.

The frog represents God's voice, speaking through the prophets and later incarnate as Christ. Like the frog's persistent pleading, God continually calls His people back, offering redemption. However, Israel initially resists, just as the princess hesitates to fulfill her promise to the frog.

Despite Israel's rejection and rebellion—culminating in the crucifixion of The Christ—God's love endures.

When the frog is thrown against the wall by the princess, it transforms into a prince, symbolizing Christ's resurrection. This transformation represents the revelation of Christ's true identity and His victory over rejection. The princess, now united with the prince, signifies Israel's eventual reconciliation with God.

The tale encapsulates Israel's reluctance to keep God's laws, their exile, and ultimate redemption through faith in Jesus Christ.

It points to a future judgment and the establishment of God's kingdom, echoing biblical prophecies of Christ's return and triumph over nations.

The Frog King serves as both a historical and prophetic allegory, urging faithfulness to the covenant and hope in the promised redemption through The Christ.

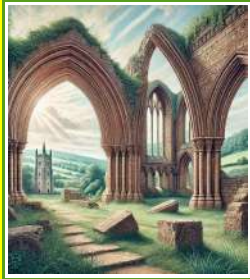

The Saxon tale of *The Seven Ravens*

intertwines with the biblical themes of Israel and the Church, reflecting the symbolism of Revelation. Israel, represented as Jacob's descendants among the Angles, Saxons, Celts, and Jutes, forms the spiritual body of Christ's Church. The 7 candlesticks in Revelation, symbolizing the Church's spiritual struggles and transformation throughout history.

The tale begins with a man who has seven sons and longs for a daughter. When she is born, her frailty necessitates immediate baptism. A quarrel among the sons over water for the ritual causes the jug to fall into the well, and in anger, the father curses them into ravens. This symbolizes the Church's divisions over doctrine, particularly baptism, and its susceptibility to spiritual darkness (represented by the ravens' blackness).

The daughter grows up unaware of her brothers until she learns of them and resolves to rescue them, symbolizing Israel's eventual recognition of and effort to redeem the Church. Her journey reflects the Church's history, from its early establishment in England to its struggles under Rome's influence, symbolized by the loss of the drumstick (God's commandments). Israel's symbolic sacrifice of her finger mirrors Christ's redemptive act, opening the way for reconciliation.

In the Glass Mountain, the ravens' transformation back to human form occurs through the sister's actions, symbolizing the Church's restoration through Israel's recognition. The ring she places in the glass symbolizes the covenant that reunites Israel and the Church, echoing Revelation's imagery of redemption and the final victory of light over darkness.

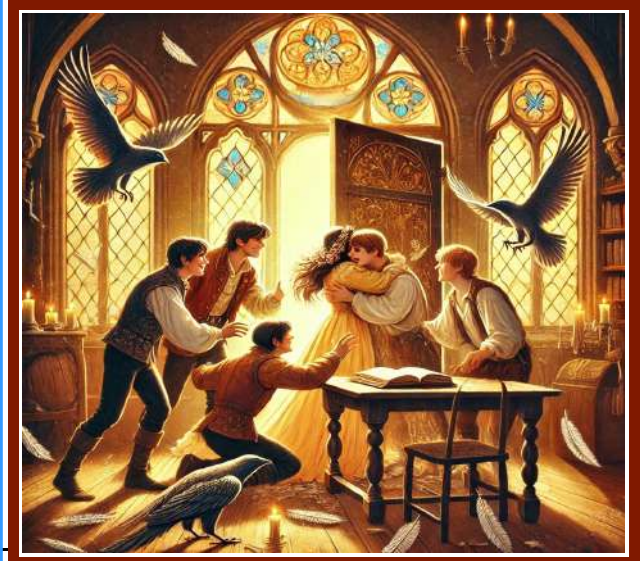
The story urges the Church to discern and recognize Israel's role in its spiritual restoration. It emphasizes vigilance and prayer, highlighting the ongoing struggle between light and darkness and the promise of Jesus' return. *The Seven Ravens* thus serves as both a reflection on the past and a guide for the Church's future.

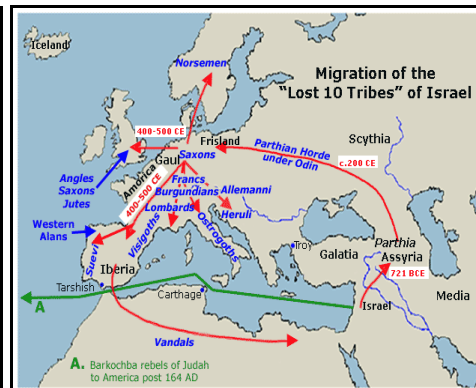
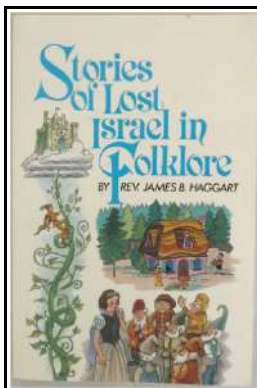
